**Saint Patrick's Church** – Open since 1837 and built to look like a castle from Ireland. Saint Patrick's Church is the oldest standing Catholic Parish in the city. The building is literally known worldwide for life-size hand wooden Stations of the Cross, massive hand painted windows and amazing column free architecture. Guided tour with a special musical treat. (1hr)

**Saint Peter's Cathedral** - Home of the Stations of the Cross in the Cathedral, paintings with gold-leafed oak frames. The twelfth station are unique, a brilliant bronze sculpture of Christ crucified. Both the cross and corpus have been ebonized. The Stations of the Cross trace the last journey of Jesus from accusation and condemnation through his final steps up Calvary, to his death and burial. Saint Peter's is also home of a crypt that is the final resting place of Erie's 6 Past Bishop, located directly beneath the high altar. (1hr)



**The Brewerie at Union Station** – Erie's Union Station was dedicated and opened to the public in a grand fashion on December 3rd, 1927. The Train station cost over 3 million dollars and was a modern marvel at the time. Encompassing two city blocks and over 100,000 square feet, the structure exhibited then-popular Art Deco influences such as stylized, geometric detailing executed in terracotta and metal. To this day it remains a symbol of the railroads' power and glory in the first half of the twentieth century. Famous Travelers include: President Franklin D. Roosevelt, President Harry Truman, Heavy Weight Boxing Champ Jack Dempsey, legendary Babe Ruth, and more!



**Arrowhead Winery** - Opened in 1998, producing internationally recognized award-winning wines. Arrowhead uses only the finest European, Native and hybrid grapes. Mostly, all grown on the Mobilia's 250 acre farm in North East, Pennsylvania. Arrowhead Wine Cellars boasts one of the Lake Erie Region's largest winery gift shops, featuring unique and one-of-a-kind gifts from New York City and around the world. Adjacent to Arrowhead Wine Cellars you'll find Mobilia Fruit Market. At the farm market you can either "pick your own" or purchase already picked fruit in season. The farm market also features frozen fruit, fresh grape juice, home wine making supplies and a wide variety of jams and jellies.



**Five and 20 Spirits and Brewing** - Produce wines that are indicative of local flavor, and have done so by working closely with local growers and utilizing local grapes & fruits. We have taken this model to another level with our new location, where each phase will grow us towards a "Grain-to-glass" operation on our 80 acre property in Westfield, NY. This will be the first facility of its kind in the Great Lake's region. "Grain-to-glass" – What's that? It means that we have taken pains to plan farming & production in such a way that the agricultural products that we use to craft the beverage that will end up in your glass don't have to travel very far.
